Peak Neurology and Sleep Medicine, LLC's 10 Most Commonly Performed Evaluation and Management Codes (99201-99499):

99213: Office visit or another outpatient visit for of an established patient.

Usually the problems presented are of low to moderate severity. Counseling and coordination of care with other healthcare providers or agencies consistent with the problems presented may also be included in the time, depending on the needs of the patient and family.

\$254.00 Unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

99214: Office visit or another outpatient visit for an established patient.

Usually the problems presented are of moderate to high severity. Counseling and coordination of care with other healthcare providers or agencies consistent with the problems presented may also be included, depending on the needs of the patient and family. **\$393.00 Unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.**

99215: Office visit or another outpatient visit for an established patient.

Usually the problems presented are of moderate to high severity. Counseling and coordination of care with other healthcare providers or agencies consistent

with the problems presented. may also be included in the time, depending on the needs of the patient and family.

\$561.00 Unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

99203: Office visit or other outpatient visit for evaluation and management of a new patient. Usually the problems presented are of moderate severity.

Counseling and coordination of care with other healthcare providers or agencies consistent with the problems presented. may also be included in the time, depending on the needs of the patient and family. **\$404.00 Unadjusted cost.**

Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

99204: Office visit or other outpatient visit for evaluation and management of a new patient. Usually the problems presented are of moderate to high severity.

Counseling and coordination of care with other healthcare providers or agencies consistent with the problems presented. may also be included in the time, depending on the needs of the patient and family. **\$609.00 Unadjusted cost.**

Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

99205: Office visit or other outpatient visit for evaluation and management of a new patient. Usually the problems presented are of moderate to high severity.

Counseling and coordination of care with other healthcare providers or agencies consistent with the problems presented. may also be included in the time, depending on the needs of the patient and/or family. **\$807.00 Unadjusted cost.**
Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

99243: Office consultation for evaluation and management of a new patient or established patient. Usually the problems presented are of moderate severity. Counseling and coordination of care with other healthcare providers or agencies consistent with the problems presented. may also be included in the time, depending on the needs of the patient and family. **\$480.00 Unadjusted cost.**
Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

99244: Office consultation for evaluation and management of a new patient or established patient. Usually the problems presented are of moderate to high severity. Counseling and coordination of care with other healthcare providers or agencies consistent with the problems presented. may also be included in the time, depending on the needs of the patient and/or family. **\$787.00 unadjusted cost.** **Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.**

99232: Subsequent hospital care, per day for evaluation and management of a patient. Counseling and coordination of care with other healthcare providers or agencies consistent with the problems presented. may also be included in the time, depending on the needs of the patient and/or family. Usually the patient is responding inadequately to therapy or has developed minor complications. **\$325.00 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.**

99233: Subsequent hospital care, per day for evaluation and management of a patient. Counseling and coordination of care with other healthcare providers or agencies consistent with the problems presented. may also be included in the time, depending on the needs of the patient and/or family. Usually the patient is unstable or has developed a complication or new problem. **\$460.00 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.**

Peak Neurology and Sleep Medicine, LLC's 10 most commonly performed Surgery Codes (10021-69990):

64615: Chemodenervation of muscles, a local injection technique, innervated by facial, trigeminal, cervical spinal and accessory nerves, bilateral. (Example:

Chronic Migraine). \$1525 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

64642: Chemodenervation, a local injection technique, of one extremity; 1-4 muscles. \$1200 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

64612: Chemodenervation of muscles, a local injection technique, innervated by facial nerve, unilateral. (Example: hemifacial spasm or blepharospasm). \$1200 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

64611: Chemodenervation of parotid and submandibular salivary glands, bilateral. \$1000 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

64616: Chemodenervation of muscles, a local injection technique, of neck muscles, excluding larynx, unilateral. (Example: Cervical dystonia). \$1200 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

64643: Chemodenervation, a local injection technique of one extremity; each additional extremity 1-4 muscles. This is an add on code if needed it is billed in conjunction with CPT code 64642. \$678.65 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

64644: Chemodenervation, a local injection technique, of one extremity; 5 or more muscles. \$1300 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

62270: Spinal puncture, lumbar, diagnostic. \$1000 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

64646: Chemodenervation, a local injection technique, trunk muscle(s) 1-5 muscle(s). \$1200 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

20552: Injection(s); single or multiple trigger points. 1-2 muscles. \$372.40 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

Peak Neurology and Sleep Medicine, LLC's 10 most commonly performed Medicine Codes (90281-99199; 99500-99607):

95806: Sleep study, unattended (at home study), simultaneous recording of heart rate, oxygen saturation, respiratory airflow and effort. \$1000 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

95806, 26: Interpretation only of a sleep study, unattended (at home study), simultaneous recording of heart rate, oxygen saturation, respiratory airflow and effort. \$400 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

95800: Sleep Study, unattended (at home study), simultaneous recording of heart rate, oxygen saturation, respiratory analysis, and sleep time. \$750 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

95800, 26: Interpretation only of a sleep study, unattended (at home study), simultaneous recording of heart rate, oxygen saturation, respiratory analysis, and

sleep time. \$350 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

95810: Polysomnography, an in-lab sleep study, age 6 years or older, sleep staging with 4 or more additional parameters of sleep. Attended by a technologist. \$5000 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

95811: Polysomnography, an in-lab sleep study, age 6 years or older, sleep staging with 4 or more additional parameters of sleep, with initiation of continuous airway pressure therapy or by level ventilation, attended by a technologist. \$5500 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

95816, 26: Interpretation only of Electroencephalogram (EEG); including recording awake and drowsy. \$915 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

95886: Needle Electromyography, each extremity, with related paraspinal areas, preformed with nerve conduction. Amplitude and latency/velocity study. five or

more muscles studied, innervated by three or more nerves or four or more spinal levels. \$700 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

94660: Continuous positive airway pressure ventilation (CPAP), initiation and management. \$262 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.

94762: Noninvasive pulse oximetry for oxygen saturation. Overnight continuous monitoring. \$250 unadjusted cost. Does not include in-network/negotiated discounts.
